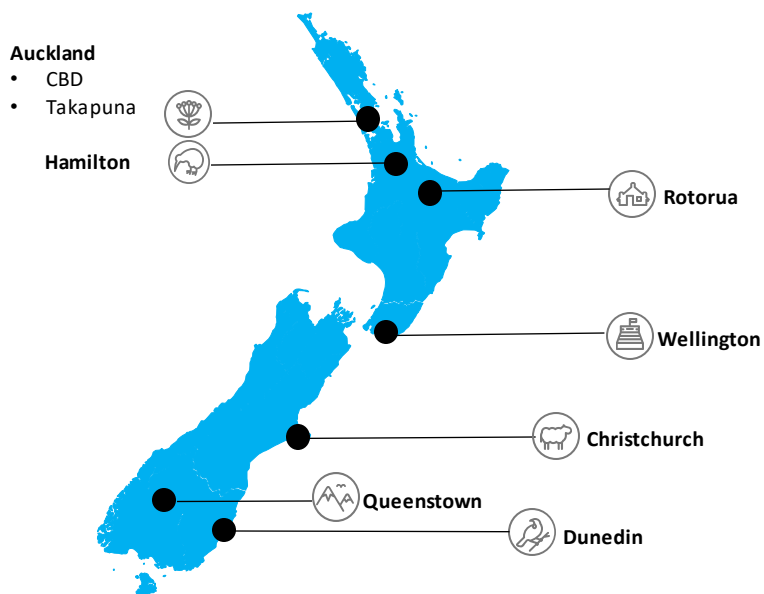

Basic data skills, in particular Excel, are now a big advantage

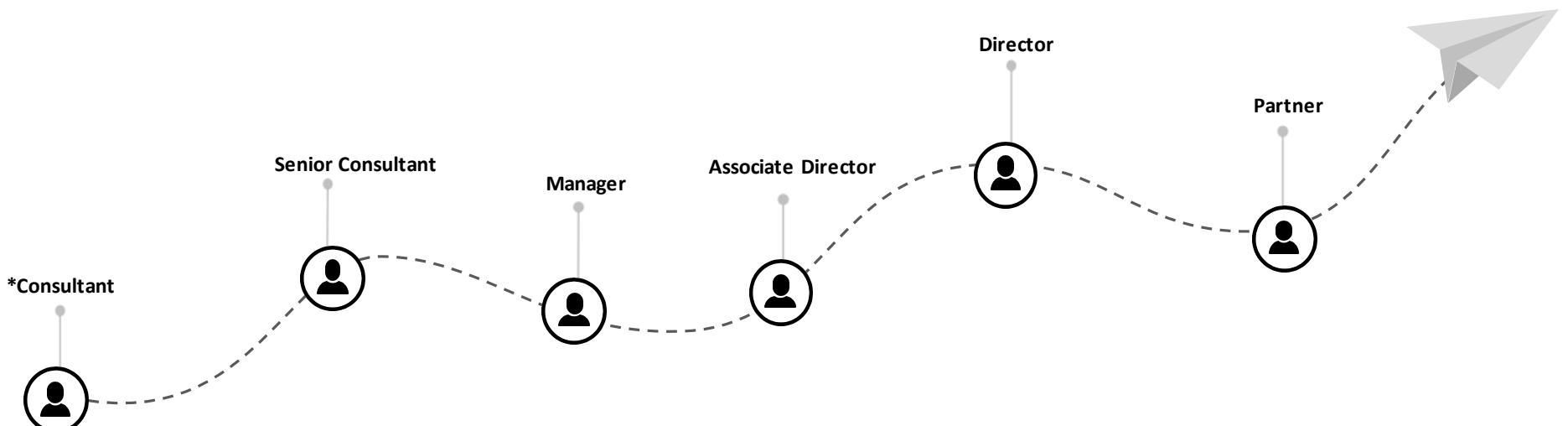


We incorporate innovative technologies to deliver valuable insights to clients about their business
